Update on works at the Belham Primary School. Steel frame being erected for the new school extension.

We are pleased to report that site works are on programme and we are making good progress with placing the steelwork that forms the frame of the new extension. We are using a self-erecting tower crane for the operation which is a great piece of kit when working in tight spaces. The frame will be completed by the end of March allowing us to continue with placing the pre-formed concrete floor slabs onto the new structure.

The construction industry mascots Ivor and Honor Goodsite visited the Belham school last week to entertain the children and pass on an important message that building sites can be dangerous places for children. The Belham site team also made a well received donation to the local Southwark food-bank on Peckham High Street.
