

Remote Education

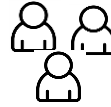
Autumn 2020



From the start of term we have been providing remote education to those children who are unable to come to school. There are two scenarios that may take place.



Individual children may have to self-isolate due to their own/household symptoms or a positive test of a close contact.



'Bubbles' may have to self-isolate should a member of their 'bubble' test positive.

What if only my child has to isolate ?



They will receive English & Maths lesson slides from their year group.



These will be posted on Class Dojo and work posted will be responded to by a teacher at The Belham



If well enough, children will be expected to complete the work set.



Subjects such as History, Art & PE will be delivered using high quality online resources.



Parents will be asked about pupils' access to technology at home .

What if the whole bubble needs to isolate?



For English & Maths, children will receive a recorded lesson showing the slides and narrated by the teacher.



Lessons and other content will be posted on Class Dojo and learning will be managed by the class teachers.



There will be a twice weekly 'class time' for children to interact with their teacher and friends.



For other subjects, class teachers will direct children to high quality online resources such as Oak National Academy.



If well, children will be expected to complete the work set and upload it to their portfolios.



Parents will be asked about pupils' access to technology at home.

What about Reception & Year 1?



As we operate a play-based curriculum they will receive their usual number of lessons plus activities to complete throughout the week. They will also have 'class time.'
