

Remote Education

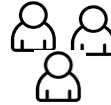

From the start of term we have been providing remote education to all children except those who have taken a face to face place due to being the child of a critical worker or have been identified as vulnerable.



All children are being offered a full curriculum which includes Art, Humanities, PE, Dance, Yoga and Class Time.



Children in school have been placed in consistent groups and are completing the same work as all children who are at home.

What can I expect?



For English & Maths, children will receive a recorded lesson showing the slides and narrated by the teacher.



Lessons and other content will be posted on Class Dojo and learning managed by the class teachers.



There will be a twice weekly 'class time' on Google Classroom for children to interact with their teacher and friends.



For other subjects, class teachers will direct children to high quality videos by our specialist teachers and online resources.



Instrumental lessons will continue. These will be delivered through Google Classroom.



If households do not have sufficient technology or connectivity they will be supported by the school.

What about Reception & Year 1?



As we operate a play-based curriculum they will receive their usual number of lessons as above plus activities to complete throughout the day or week. They will also have 'class time.'

How will you know if my child is engaging?



We have a statutory obligation to provide 3hrs+ for EYFS/KS1 and 4hrs+ for KS2 of learning each day.



We know that doing all of this work will be a challenge. We are asking that English & Maths are submitted as a minimum.



Next day feedback will be given on work sent in by 1pm. After this time feedback may not be received by the next day.



We will stay in contact with you. If completing the work is a challenge, do let us know. We are here to support you.
