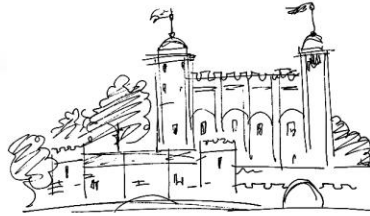

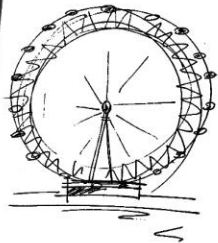

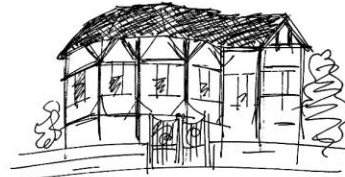
Coding

- Proofreading for accuracy

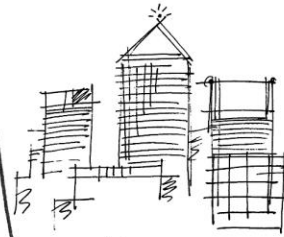

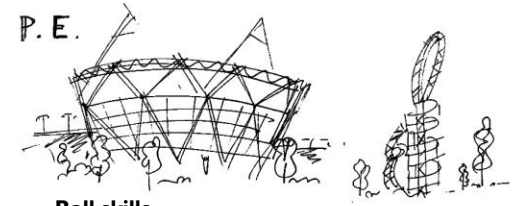

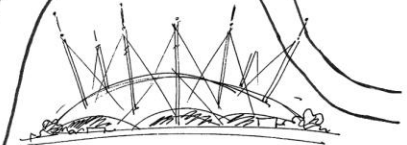
