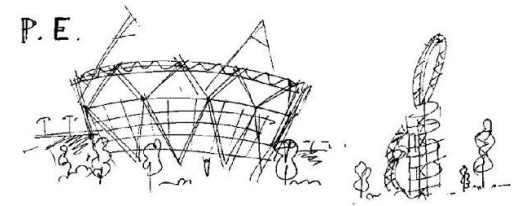
Rocks and Soils

Light

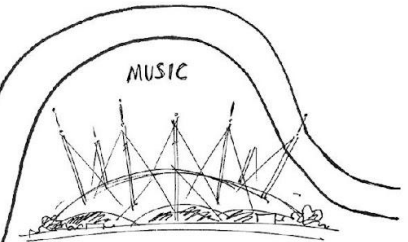
- Working scientifically using practical enquires and comparative and fair tests.
